**Notification**

It is hereby notified that the End Semester Examinations including Make-Up Examinations of VII and VIII Semesters 2020 – 21 shall be held following the academic calendar already announced. Laboratory and project classes of the VIII Semester shall also be held as per the announced schedule.

Any student, who fail to appear fully or partly in the above examinations, due to cogent reasons including difficulty in travel due to the Covid 19 pandemic, shall be evaluated in the course(s) which she/ he has missed on the basis of her/his performance in that/ those course(s) in the mid semester and quizzes, home assignments etc. The total marks for the evaluation of performance in a course shall be 40 out of 100. Requirement of appearing in the end semester examinations or their make-up examinations shall be waived off and grades be awarded. The highest grades shall be C\*.

For incomplete laboratory or project work of Eighth Semester a letter 'T' would appear on the grade report with explanatory note that it stands for waiver granted for the course. All such courses and/ or requirement will not be considered in the final calculation of the SPI/ CPI.

As a special case, due to the difficulty faced by students in appearing fully or partly in the above examination(s) due to Covid 19 pandemic the two examinations (i) B. Tech Seventh Semester (Spl) End Semester Examination 2020 – 21 and (ii) B. Tech. Eighth Semester (Spl) End Semester Examination 2020 – 21 shall be conducted on later dates. All students who could not appear fully or partly in an End Semester Examination or its Make Up Examination shall be eligible to appear in the respective Special Examination. For the evaluation of performance in the Special Examination, a 100 % weightage shall be given to the End Semester Examination of the Special Examination, i.e., there shall not be any sessional or mid semester examination. Grade report of any Special Examination shall replace the grade report of the earlier End Semester Examination.

A time slot shall also be announced by the Institute to complete the courses for which a letter "T" appeared in the grade report. The letter "T" shall also be replaced in the grade reports of the Special Examination by the grades awarded.
