NOTIFICATION

The Merit-cum-means scholarship guideline is revised for the students admitted in academic year 2019-20 and subsequent years. The following guideline shall be followed for the undergraduate students admitted in different years.

- The earlier scholarship provision in Merit-cum-Means category is abolished. Under the new provision, a 10% of the total programme wise students rounded off to the next higher number will receive tution fee waiver of 25%.
- All students whose annual family income is ≤ Rs. 5 lakhs are eligible to apply for the scholarship
- Amongst the eligible candidates, latest CPI/SPI will be considered as the criteria for the selection.
- Candidate once selected will continue to receive fee waiver in subsequent semesters subjected to the following conditions;
 - o His/her CPI/SPI doesn't fall below 6.5 and he/she doesn't receive any Fail grade (F, I, Z).
 - The candidate need to submit family income certificate each year and the income shall not exceed the threshold limit (Rs. 5 Lakhs).
- Once discontinued, the candidate will not be eligible for re-consideration.
- Any vacancy created thereof, shall be filled with the next candidate in the waitlist, which was
 prepared at the time of deciding the award.

For the students admitted in 2019-20:

- The fee waiver will be applicable from 3rd semester onwards. The list of eligible candidates will be decided on the basis of the CPI of the 2rd semester.
- The candidate must not have failed in any subject of 1st and 2nd semester and the CPI must be >6.5.

For the students admitted in 2020-21 and subsequent years:

- The list will be announced based on the performance of the 1st semester and 25% of the tuition fee of the 1st semester and subsequent semester (if already paid) will be refunded.
- After the scholarship merit list is announced, the selected candidates will be required to pay 75% of the tuition fee along with other dues as applicable to all students from the following semesters.
